Skills That Work for Wales is a three year skills and employment strategy and action plan where the Welsh Assembly Government outline its commitment to creating the skilled workforce that Wales needs to be competitive and profitable in years ahead.

The Welsh Assembly Government and Government Skills have worked closely to ensure that *'Building professional skills for government: a strategy for delivery'* will prepare the workforce for the future challenges of central government within the Principality. It will do this by: delivering integrated skills and business support; ensuring that investment is made in the right qualifications; encouraging quality skills provision and expanding the supply of people and skills.

As an employer, the Welsh Assembly Government has implemented the PSG competency framework. It has embedded it within its recruitment policy, performance management system and own competency framework for all grades.

Government Skills has established effective relationships with employers and networks with other sector skills agencies in Wales. Collaborating with a wide range of partners (Higher Education Funding Council for Wales, Job Centre Plus, Wales Trades Union Congress and Careers Wales) Government Skills has developed action plans to implement the skills strategy for Government and to ensure that it fully reflects the skills landscape in Wales.
